

## RADIOCOMMUNICATIONS ACT 1983

### ASSIGNMENT OF PART OF THE SPECTRUM TO THE AUSTRALIAN BROADCASTING AUTHORITY FOR PLANNING

WHEREAS subsection 18(3) of the *Radiocommunications Act 1983* provides that the Minister may, after consultation with the Australian Broadcasting Authority and in accordance with the spectrum plan, assign by instrument in writing a part of the spectrum designated as being primarily for broadcasting purposes to the ABA for planning in accordance with Part 3 of the *Broadcasting Services Act 1992*:

AND WHEREAS the ABA has been consulted on assignment of part of the spectrum to it for planning:

AND WHEREAS I am satisfied that assignment to the ABA for that purpose of part of the spectrum referred to in the Schedule, being a part of the spectrum designated in the spectrum plan as being primarily for broadcasting purposes, would be in accordance with the spectrum plan:

NOW THEREFORE I, Robert Lindsay Collins, the Minister of State for Transport and Communications, in pursuance of subsection 18(3) of the *Radiocommunications Act 1983*, hereby assign to the Australian Broadcasting Authority the part of the spectrum referred to in the Schedule for planning in accordance with Part 3 of the *Broadcasting Services Act 1992*.
