I would like to add my support for the ideas presented by Simon Hackett during his speech to attendees of the CommsDay summit which can be viewed for reference at <http://www.veoh.com/videos/v10201149JrtHghqd>

Primarily the focus should be on the retention of all existing ADSL hardware installed by ISPs other than Telstra as an absolute guarantee that a total vertical monopoly is not set in place by the new network.

We must avoid at all cost the return to a situation where Telstra has sole control of the entire infrastructure. They have proved over the last 5 years that they will whenever possible push the boundaries of regulatory control, and use legal, but unethical delay tactics to put all competitors at a gross disadvantage. Given a return to even greater control than they currently enjoy, we can only expect dramatic increases in retail costs to consumers.
